

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FROM RNF BURSARY APPLICANTS**

### **When are RNF Bursary Applications available?**

In mid-May. Application packages are updated yearly. You MUST use the most current application. Bursary packages are available from Schools of Nursing in B.C., CRNBC and from RNF's website: [www.rnfbc.ca](http://www.rnfbc.ca) from mid-May to mid-September.

### **When are bursaries awarded?**

In December. Only Bursary Winners are contacted.

### **Are bursaries retrospective, i.e., for courses already completed or about to be completed?**

Not for courses already completed. If you are currently enrolled in a course you may apply.

### **May I apply for a bursary, if I am studying outside B.C.?**

Yes, but only if you are a resident of B.C., and if an RN, a CRNBC registrant.

### **May I apply for more than one bursary?**

Yes, as long as you meet the qualifications. (Read Information Form which includes bursary descriptions). Submit only one application and one set of documentation.

### **What are the amounts of bursary awards?**

They vary, but range from \$500 – \$1,000.

### **How are Winners selected?**

Randomly by lottery.

### **Are bursaries based on financial need?**

Different criteria apply to each bursary and only a few require a statement of financial need. Read Information and Applications Forms carefully.

### **Are bursaries available for part-time studies?**

Some, so read the Information Form to find out about specific requirements for each bursary.

### **If I apply for more than one bursary, do I have to supply documentation for each bursary?**

No, one set of documentation is sufficient.
